1. Organizational

Outrigger canoe races on the island of Rügen at the Baltic Sea resort of Sellin, an event for athletes, friends and the whole family:

Period: 08.-10. August 2024

Location: Baltic Sea resort of Sellin, south beach

Costs: 115,- Euro per participant

- Catering and supervision of the participants (incl. daily catering water/fruit, 2 x dinner)

2. Course of the race:

The race will run southeast along the island of Rügen.

In 3 stages, a total of approx. 93km paddled.

1. Race day

On the first day of the race, the marathon stage with a length of about 46km is planned. The teams can change paddlers here after the first 14km on the south beach of Thiessow. After a circuit of 18km on the Greifswalder Bodden, we change back to Thiessow and paddle back the last 14km to the destination Sellin Südstrand.

• 2. Race day

On the second day of the race, stages 2 and 3 will take place. A change of crew can take place directly on the south beach Sellin.

Stage 2 is a double course towards Binz. After 16 km you change at the south beach and the second round of 7km is paddled towards Göhren.

Stage 3 runs as a triangular circuit and is paddled a total of 4 times (4x6km). A change of paddlers can take place in each round. At least once, however, it must be changed! The overall winner of the event will be determined by the total time of all 3 stages. Depending on weather conditions, the route and schedule may vary.

(The Org. team reserves the right to make changes and will inform you on the day of the race.)

5. Boat material:

Each boat must be equipped as follows:

- 1 main boat, 1 outrigger (Ama)
- 2 spars (lako's) for attaching the boom to the fuselage
- •Fixed control devices are prohibited

Boat rental

- There is the possibility of boat rental on site!
- 4 Va'a V6 are available
- Teams with a long journey or from abroad can take advantage of this option
- If necessary, please contact us, coordination will take place between the team and the rental company

6. Safety/ Equipment:

The following equipment must be proven and carried by each team.

- 1. The outriggers must be equipped with spray decks
- 2. Every athlete is obliged to wear or carry a life jacket during the race.
- 3. A safety line must be stretched between the iakos. In dangerous situations, positions 3 & 4 can prevent the boat from capsizing.
- 4. A **tow rope with a length of at least 15m** is to be attached to the front lake on the six-seater and carried during the race.
- 5. At least 2 ladles must be carried in the six-seater
- 6. It is recommended that you carry a mobile phone with a stored phone number.
- 7. Spare paddle attached to the boat

Each team should also know and master the re-boarding as well as the procedures after a boat capsize. In general, each team is obliged to act in the interests of safety, mutual consideration and assistance are also mandatory.

Refusal to provide assistance can lead to exclusion from the event!

7. Other:

Pleas

We wish for a friendly, fair and eventful competition. However, if there are discrepancies, objections are possible and must be submitted in writing. The objectionfee is 50 euros, must be paid immediately and is non-refundable. Appeals must be submitted no later than 20 minutes after the arrival of the last canoe of each stage.

Punish

The Org. team is responsible for pronouncing the following penalties:

- Warning
- Time penalty
- Lowering the placement
- Disqualification or exclusion from the race
